Subject + have/has + past participle

I	have	lived
You	have	lived
He/She/It	has	lived
We	have	lived
You	have	lived
They	have	lived

Contraction

I've lived You've lived He's/She's/It's lived We've lived You've lived They've lived



NEGATIVE

Subject + have/has + not + past participle

have	not	lived
have	not	lived
has	not	lived
have	not	lived
have	not	lived
have	not	lived
	have has have have	have not has not have not have not

Contraction

I've not lived =	I haven't lived
You've not lived =	You haven't lived
He' <mark>s/She's/It's</mark> not lived =	He/She/It hasn't lived
We've not lived =	We haven't lived
You've not lived =	You haven't lived
They've not lived =	They haven't lived
